Supporting the needs of our young people

Intensive support for Care Experienced students: Tracking of wellbeing, attainment and achievement, ensuring all Care Experienced students achieve qualifications and belong to at least one school club.

The Larder: Targeted students will attend The Larder and achieve the NPA Craft Bakery Award. We will support ASN students to access the curriculum and develop

their potential.



Family Link Worker

By consistently monitoring attendance data, our family link worker will work with targeted pupils and their families to improve wellbeing, engagement and attendance with home visits as required.



Creating inclusive classrooms

Maths Recovery: We are maintaining the Maths Recovery programme, providing further training and resources as required.

Target Literacy:

As a result of ongoing assessment and review, literacy support for S1 and S2 pupils is provided through the Read, Write, Inc and Fresh Start programme.



Equity of opportunity

We will continue to support our learning community to navigate the current developments in our school building.



Our Team

Staffing: A staff member (1 day a week) focusses on organising and monitoring projects and interventions.

Employability Hub:

Supporting targeted S3 and S4 students to achieve 5+ National 5 qualifications.

Staff training: Expanding understanding of tracking and monitoring data, measures and outcomes. This will identify poverty related gaps in classes.
